Catechism Signups 2024-25

The Sisters will be having 2024-25 catechism signups **after all Masses on August 11 and 18 at both parishes.** Children needing First Communion must be 7 years old by May 1 2025 to enroll for this year. Children needing Confirmation must be 12 years old by Easter Vigil, April 19, 2025. No exceptions to this policy. Only registered parishioners, and those who intend to register and make the Oratory Family of Parishes their permanent home when registration re-opens, may sign up for the classes.
