### Guidelines for Parking - Old St. Mary's

Green parking passes are only valid when the lots have been reserved for official Church events. Parking passes must be displayed on your vehicle dash when using OSM lots after 5 p.m. and when using the Salvation Army lots. Failure to do so will result in your vehicle being towed. Use of passes outside of official Church events will also result in your vehicle being towed.

- Double parking is permitted in the OSM P2 lot only. Double parking in any of the other OSM and Salvation Army lots will result in your vehicle being towed.
- If you decide to double park in the OSM P2 lot, please be respectful of other parishioners and have your vehicle out of the right-of-way immediately following Mass.
- Use of parking passes for any non-church-related activities is prohibited and will result in your vehicle being towed.
- Gates on the Salvation Army P3 lot will be locked at 2:00 p.m. each Sunday. Vehicles remaining in this lot after that time will be towed.
