On January 1, we will change or recite the Veni Creator after Masses to invoke God's blessings upon us in the new year. If you join us for these acts, receive Holy Communion, have made Sacramental Confession within 20 days, are free from all attachment to sin, and say the prayers for the Holy Father's intentions, you can gain these indulgences. OUR FAITH
